

Practice Nurse Clinical Lead for Worcestershire:



Are you interested in an exciting challenge, a development opportunity and help shape the practice nursing workforce in Worcestershire?

Worcestershire CCGs are looking to recruit a Practice Nurse Lead (Band 8a) to support general practice nursing over the next 12 months. This is an exciting post which will be on a fixed term basis working with the CEPNs, LMC and CCGs 1 day per week.

What we are looking for:

An experienced practice nurse or Advanced Nurse Practitioner who is interested in workforce development, training and education and is passionate about encouraging new nurses into primary care. Candidates should be currently working in a Worcestershire General Practice and with an interest in developing clinical leadership skills to support Practice Nurse development.

There will be 4 main themes to the role:

1. Work alongside Worcestershire CEPN to advise on clinical education for practice nurses and be a point of contact for local practice nurses.
2. Work with Worcestershire LMC and CEPN to establish a regular practice nurse forum and ensure that the right clinical education is delivered at these events to support our existing nursing workforce needs.
3. Liaise with the Nurse Facilitator at Worcester University to give additional support to practices who are considering taking on or have a student nurse on placement in their practice.
4. Influence local implementation of the National 10 Point General Practice Nursing plan working with other clinicians and the CCGs in the GPFV team as part of the STP.

This post will sit within the CCGs Nursing and Quality team and mentorship will be provided by Dr Jonathan Leach as the Lead GP across Primary Care.
