

# Teaching the Teachers: Skills for Healthcare Educators

## 3 day workshop

This 3 day workshop will enhance and refresh your skills as a facilitator of the educational journey of others. All healthcare professionals are engaged in teaching, whether informally for patients or peers or more formally with junior colleagues.

Using an experiential approach we will share the expertise in the group, underpinned with educational theory to look closely at our teaching role.

We will consider how learners learn, how to support learners in difficulty and challenging trainees, and how to identify our own learning needs.

Aligned to the UK Academy of Medical Educators standards, the workshop will enable participants to demonstrate their competence for revalidation as a trainer.

### The workshop content includes:

- Principles of assessment and curriculum design
- Constructive alignment in teaching
- Leadership skills for educators
- Tips and ideas for developing the skills to supporting training/education at practice and Primary Care Network level

### Target audience

This workshop is aimed at GPs interested in teaching and educational supervision, who have not completed a basic skills course, or who wish to refresh and enhance their teaching. It will satisfy the GMC requirements for revalidation of trainers but can also lead as an entry point into higher study for a PGCertMedEd. This course is aimed at Mid-Career GPs who are interested in Medical Education and do not want the commitment of the post-graduate qualification
